North Korea may be preparing to resume testing engines used to power intercontinental ballistic missiles (ICBMs) at its Sohae Launch Facility, which leader Kim Jong-un had once agreed to dismantle

Jul 2017: Pyonyang successfully test-fires **Hwasong-14 (KN-20)** ICBM with range of 6,700-10,000km. Missile can potentially hit U.S. mainland with nuclear warhead

2012-19: Since Kim Jong-un assumed office in December 2011, North Korea has conducted 101 missile tests
