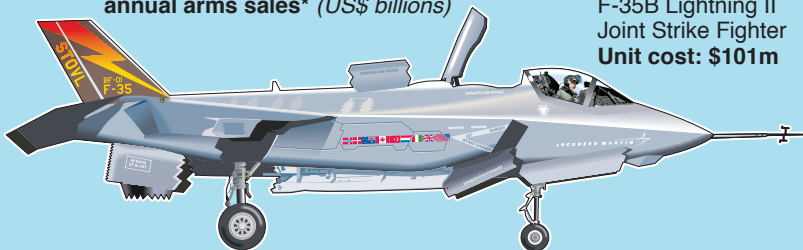


# Top arms-producing companies

Arms sales of the world's 100 largest arms-producing and military services companies hit \$420.4 billion in 2018, an increase of 4.6 percent compared with 2017, according to the SIPRI Top 100
