▲ **The Soviet Communist Party leadership agreed to surrender its 70-year monopoly on power, paving the way for a multi-party democracy**

1870: Austrian psychoanalyst Alfred Adler, who developed the concept of the “inferiority complex”, was born

1932: The “neutron”, a neutral particle in the nucleus of atoms, was first reported in *Nature* by James Chadwick

1940: The world premiere of Walt Disney’s film *Pinocchio* took place

1968: The leaders of all 10 provinces of Canada agreed to give the French language equal status with English
