▲ **World War II's "Big Three", Churchill, Stalin and Roosevelt, met at Yalta to map out the future of post-war Europe and agree plans to found the United Nations**

1975: Conservative Margaret Thatcher became the first woman leader of a British political party

1995: The fragile peace in Bosnia broke down as Serbs and Croats disputed the region of Krajina

2010: A court in Beijing rejected an appeal by prominent Chinese dissident Liu Xiaobo against his 11-year jail term

2010: Iran declared it was now a nuclear state following a successful 20% uranium enrichment
