

Airbus looks to build on record jet deliveries

European aviation giant Airbus is planning to break its own record and boost aircraft deliveries to an all-time high in 2020, as rival Boeing continues to struggle in the aftermath of the 737 MAX crisis

2020: Airbus plans to deliver 880 aircraft, up from record 863 in 2019

Airbus A320 series: Production rate expected to increase from 60 per month to as many as 67 per month by 2023

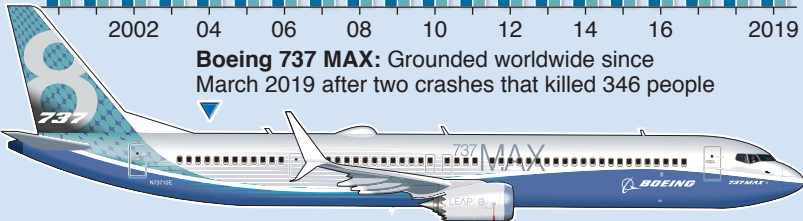
