

UK's post-Brexit immigration system

Under the British government's points-based immigration system – which will come into force at the start of 2021 – both EU and non-EU citizens will have to gain 70 points to be eligible to apply for a visa



Home Secretary Priti Patel: Migrants who “have the right kind of skills” will be welcome
