▲ **U.S. President Lyndon Johnson authorized the use in Vietnam of napalm, a petroleum-based anti-personnel bomb that sticks to skin and causes severe burns**

1995: Fast-food restaurants in Los Angeles were reported to be responsible for nine times more pollution than the city's buses

2000: Ecuador received \$2 billion in IMF aid as it replaced its currency, the sucre, with the U.S. dollar

2010: Indonesian terrorist Dulmatin was killed in a police raid in Jakarta

2015: Apple unveiled its hotly anticipated smartwatch, with prices ranging from \$349 up to \$10,000
