April 4, 1873

▲ **The Kennel Club, the world's oldest and first official registry of purebred dogs, was founded in Britain. As of 2020, it recognised 218 breeds of dog**

1932: Vitamin C was first isolated from lemon juice. This led to the prevention of scurvy

1955: The new atomic testing site in South Australia was named Maralinga, the Aboriginal word for thunder

1975: A U.S. air force transport plane carrying Vietnamese orphans crashed in Saigon, killing 155 children

1994: The Netscape Communications Corporation, of the once dominant browser Netscape, was founded
