

Apple launches new cheap iPhone

With the global economy weakened by the coronavirus pandemic, Apple has introduced a cheaper second-generation *iPhone SE*

iPhone SE (2nd generation)*

Form factor recycles design of *iPhone 8* (launched in 2017)

Cost-saving features

No **Face ID** system, which in costlier iPhone models requires sensors, cameras and dot projector to create 3D map of user's face

Single-lens front and back cameras

No **3D Touch** display†

Touch ID fingerprint scanner instead of Face ID

Same **A13 Bionic Neural Engine** chip used in more expensive iPhones. Allows it to take **Portrait mode** photographs and play power-hungry **Apple Arcade** games, such as forthcoming title, **The Pathless**
