

Europe easing coronavirus lockdown

Some European countries are starting to gradually ease restrictions imposed to limit the spread of coronavirus disease (Covid-19), amid a slowing trend in the number of new infections



Czech Rep.

Outdoor sports allowed from Apr 7. Gradual return of shops and restaurants from Apr 20 to Jun 8



Spain: Return of manufacturing and construction work on Apr 13. Other restrictions apply until at least Apr 26



Italy: Lockdown in place until May 3. Stationers and children's clothing shops allowed to reopen on Apr 14



Austria

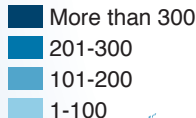
Return of smaller shops, DIY stores and garden centres on Apr 14. Larger stores and shopping malls open from May 1



Denmark

Reopening of nurseries, day care centres and primary schools on Apr 15. Other curbs apply until May 10

Finland

Roadblocks lifted around Helsinki on Apr 15. Schools and public places closed until May 13



Poland

Lockdown eased from Apr 19 but borders closed until May 3



Germany

Reopening of small shops on Apr 20, followed by schools from May 4



Norway

Kindergartens to open on Apr 20 and schools up to fourth grade on Apr 27
