May 15, 1940

▲ **Nylon stockings went on sale throughout the United States, priced at \$1.15 per pair. Around 780,000 pairs were sold on the first day alone**

1940: Brothers Richard and Maurice McDonald opened their first restaurant

1955: Britain, France, the U.S. and the USSR signed the Vienna Treaty to restore Austria's independence

1995: China conducted an underground nuclear test just days after agreeing to an extension of the nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty

2015: U.S. citizen Dzhokhar Tsarnaev was sentenced to death for his role in the 2013 Boston Marathon bombings
