June 4, 1896

▲ Henry Ford test drove his first car, the quadricycle, in Detroit. The vehicle had a simple frame fitted with a gas-powered engine and four bicycle wheels

1940: The evacuation of allied forces from Dunkirk was completed

1994: Bangladesh ordered the arrest of feminist writer Taslima Nasrin after she said the Koran should be “thoroughly revised”

2010: SpaceX’s Falcon 9 rocket was successfully launched on its maiden test flight from Cape Canaveral

2015: The data of at least four million U.S. federal employees was breached by computer hackers traced to China
