▲ **British citizens voted by a 2-1 majority to stay in the Common Market in the first ever national referendum to be held throughout the United Kingdom**

1995: Ethiopian runner Haile Gebrselassie knocked nine seconds off the world 10,000 metres record

2003: The SARS epidemic peaked, by which time the death toll had reached 775 worldwide

2005: Reports emerged that Taiwan had successfully test-fired a cruise missile capable of reaching China

2017: Saudi Arabia, the UAE, Bahrain, Yemen and Egypt broke off diplomatic relations with Qatar
