▲ The presidents of North and South Korea, Kim Jong-il (right) and Kim Dae-jung met for the first ever summit between the bitterly divided countries

1990: East Germany began the final demolition of the Berlin Wall, built in 1961 during the Cold War

1995: France announced a series of eight nuclear tests at Mururoa Atoll in the Pacific

2015: The Philae space probe briefly reawakened seven months after landing on comet 67P/CG

2019: The U.S. alleged that attacks on two oil tankers in the Gulf of Oman were carried out by Iran
