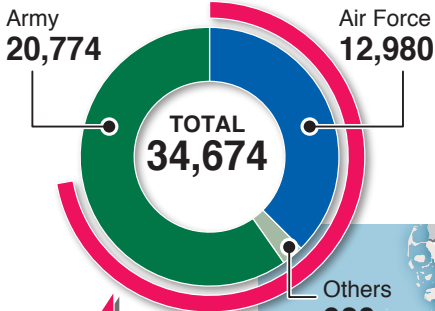


# Trump orders U.S. troop cut in Germany
