

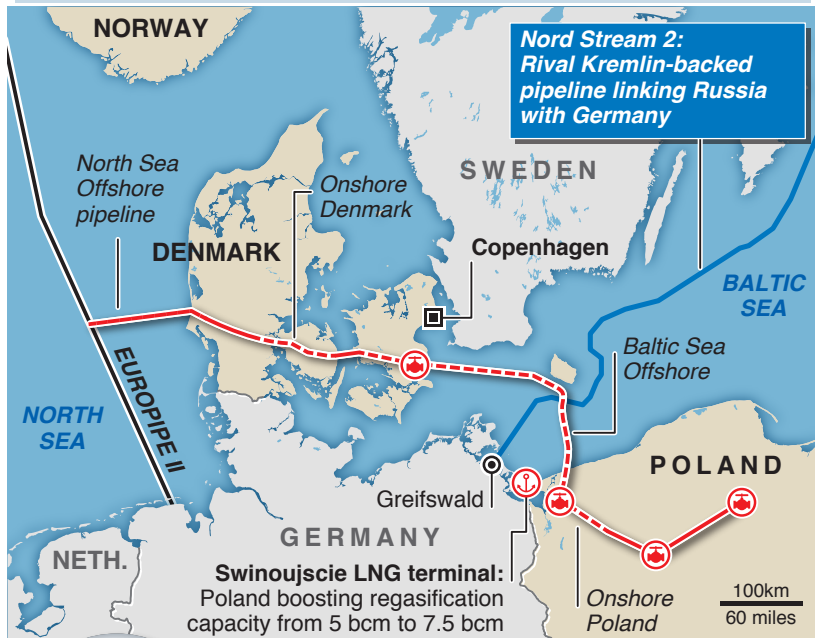
# Poland to break reliance on Russian gas

The Baltic Pipe, a €1.6bn project linking Poland with Norway's gasfields, will shake up energy markets in central Europe and help Warsaw cut its decades-long dependence on Russian gas supplies

## BALTIC PIPE PROJECT

- Joint enterprise between **Gaz System** and Danish counterpart **Energinet**
- Capacity:** 10 billion cubic metres (bcm) per year. *Poland sources 9 bcm of its 17 bcm annual gas demand from Russia*

- Length:** 900km
- Operational:** Oct 2022. Warsaw's contract with Russia's **Gazprom** expires 2022 – no intention to renew

Interconnectors to Lithuania, Slovakia and Czech Republic will allow Poland to route excess gas to neighbouring countries in central Europe
