

Guyana on verge of oil wealth

Guyana, one of South America's poorest countries, could potentially become one of the world's richest following the discovery by ExxonMobil of huge offshore oil reserves

ExxonMobil Exxon-led venture projected to produce at least 750,000 barrels per day by 2025 – enough for Guyana to become oil power alongside neighbouring Venezuela and Brazil

Stabroek block: Recoverable resources estimated to be more than 8 billion barrels of oil equivalent
