

Polish president Duda wins second term

Poland's conservative incumbent Andrzej Duda won a narrow majority in the country's presidential election, defeating liberal Warsaw mayor Rafal Trzaskowski, according to a near complete count of votes

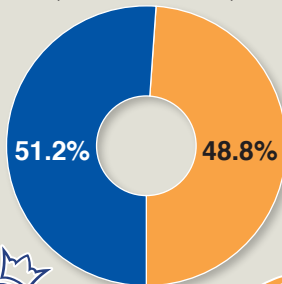


Andrzej Duda
