

# UK immigration rules from 2021

EU and non-EU workers will be equally assessed under Britain's post-Brexit points-based immigration system. An applicant must score at least 70 points to qualify for entry

## NON-TRADEABLE POINTS: 50 required (mandatory)

Offer of job by approved sponsor	20
Job at appropriate skill level	20
English language skills at level B1 (intermediate)	10

## TRADEABLE POINTS: 20 required (applicant may only score from one entry from each of two sections below)

## ADDITIONAL VISA ROUTES

**Health and care visa:** For key health professionals, providing faster and cheaper processing. Visa will exclude social care workers

**Graduates:** From summer 2021, international students will be able to stay in Britain for at least two years after finishing their studies
