

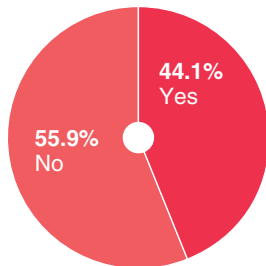
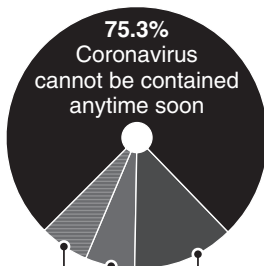
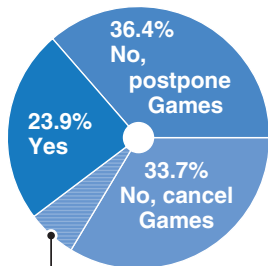
Japanese wary over Tokyo Olympics

Less than one in four people in Japan are in favour of holding next summer's Tokyo Games as scheduled, according to a new poll

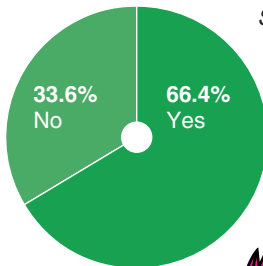
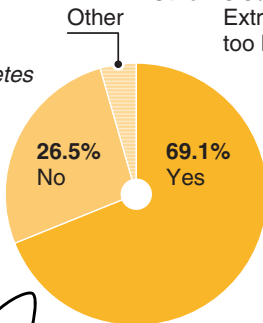
Should 2021 Tokyo Olympics go ahead?
