# PGA Championship champions

The inaugural PGA Championship in 1916 was won by Jim Barnes from England in a 36-hole final at Siwanoy Country Club, New York. He received the Wanamaker trophy and \$500 in prize money. In the 101 tournaments since, home favourites have claimed 83 titles
