▲ **Future Wimbledon champion Althea Gibson became the first African-American player to be admitted to the U.S. Lawn Tennis Association**

1680: Pueblo Indians took possession of what is now Santa Fe, New Mexico, driving out over 2,000 Spanish settlers

1960: Mau Mau guerrilla leader Jomo Kenyatta was freed after nine years detention in Kenya

1990: Images of Venus taken by the Magellan space probe showed valleys and volcanoes similar to those on Earth

2010: Russian engineers began loading fuel into Iran's first nuclear reactor at Bushehr
