One of the fastest growth areas in robotics is the business of delivering goods.

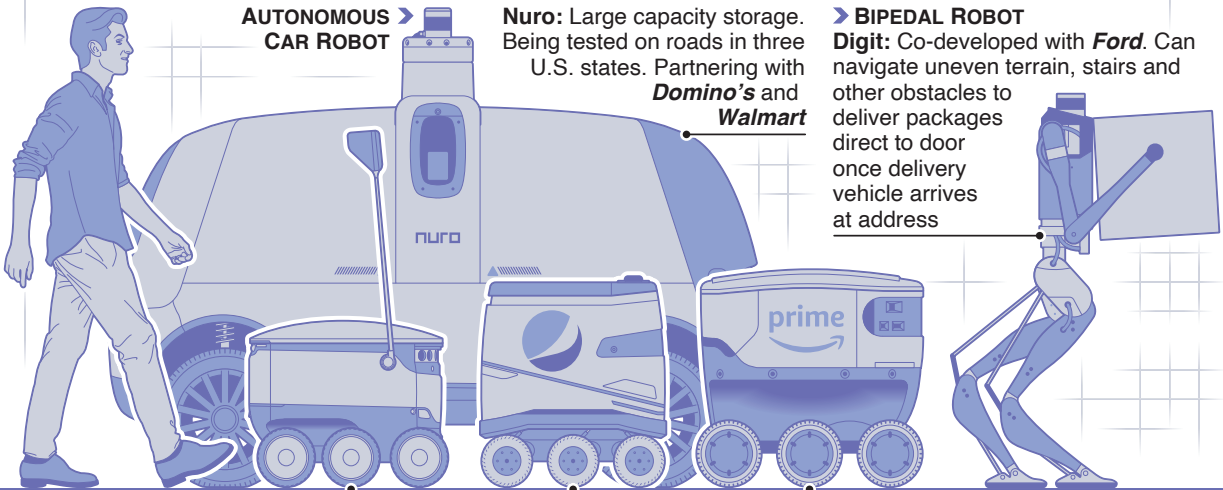
Several tech firms, including Amazon, are trialling their own technologies

AUTONOMOUS CAR ROBOT

Nuro: Large capacity storage. Being tested on roads in three U.S. states. Partnering with **Domino's** and **Walmart**

BIPEDAL ROBOT

Digit: Co-developed with **Ford**. Can navigate uneven terrain, stairs and other obstacles to deliver packages direct to door once delivery vehicle arrives at address



SIDEWALK-DRIVING ROBOTS

Starship: Pioneering six-wheeled delivery robot can climb steps and take packages direct to door. Has been tested in over 100 cities in 20 countries

Robby: Championed by **PepsiCo** who use their **Snackbot** iterations to deliver food and drink to students at U.S. university campuses – think of them as mobile vending machines

Scout: Online retail giant **Amazon** has developed its own six-wheeler, launched in 2019. Currently delivering **Prime** member parcels in four U.S. states
