

Nations rally to send aid to Beirut

Dozens of countries and international organisations have lined up to help Lebanon after Beirut's devastating explosion



Blast killed at least 154 people, injured around 5,000 others, and left 300,000 homeless

France's President **Emmanuel Macron** vows to convene international fundraising conference with aid to be sent directly to relief organisations



Other countries sending food, medical supplies and rescue teams include: **Bangladesh, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Egypt, Greece, Iran, Iraq, Italy, Jordan, Kuwait, Netherlands, Poland, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, Turkey and UAE**

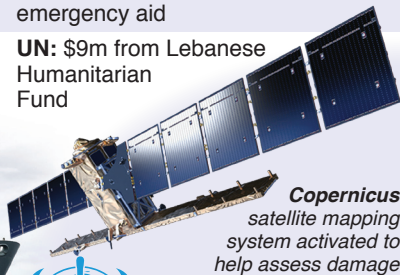
