September 6, 1566

▲ **Suleiman the Magnificent, Sultan of the Ottoman Empire, died. He presided over the empire at the apex of its military, political and economic power**

1965: India invaded West Pakistan over Kashmir. Almost 2,500 Indians died in the ensuing 17-day war

2000: The Bridgestone tyre company apologised for recent deaths in accidents involving tyre failures

2000: Fidel Castro shook hands for the first time with a sitting U.S. President, Bill Clinton

2019: Former Zimbabwean president Robert Mugabe died aged 95. He was ousted in 2017 after a 37-year rule
