

Public trust in vaccines on rise

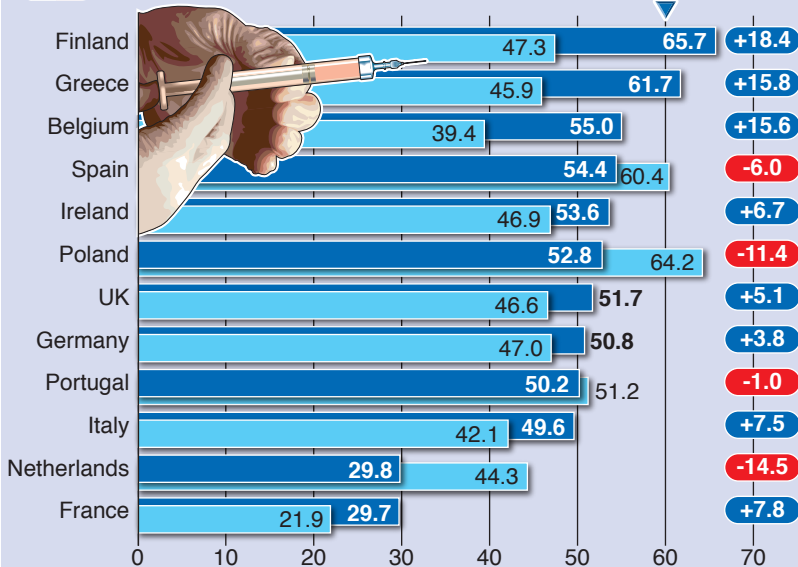
A survey of public confidence in vaccines suggests that a Covid-19 jab would have good take-up in Europe. The study comes amid fears that the number of people willing to be vaccinated might be falling
