▲ Skydiver Felix Baumgartner made the highest ever freefall from a balloon 39km over New Mexico, becoming the first man to travel faster than the speed of sound

1991: Bulgarians celebrated the end of the Communist Party's grasp on power

1995: Italy's former prime minister Silvio Berlusconi was ordered to stand trial on corruption charges

2007: The 2,500-year old marble sculptures from the Acropolis were moved to a new museum in Athens

2019: Protests erupted in Barcelona after nine Catalan separatist leaders were jailed over the failed 2017 independence bid
