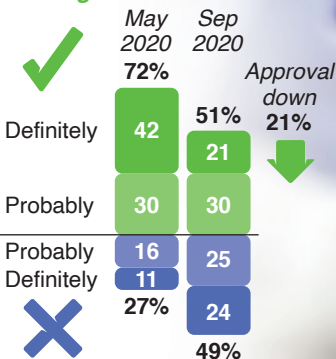


# Falling U.S. approval for Covid-19 vaccine

Around half of Americans say they would not get a vaccine to prevent Covid-19, if it were available today – up from 27% four months ago

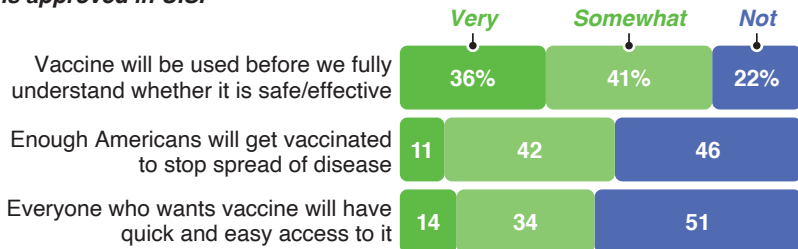
**% of U.S. adults who say if vaccine to prevent Covid-19 were available today, they...**
