▲ **Chrysanthemums were introduced into England from China, where they were cultivated as a flowering herb as far back as the 15th century BC**

1880: Australian outlaw Ned Kelly was hanged in Melbourne for the murder of three police constables

1917: Cutex made the first modern liquid nail polish using nitrocellulose, a chemical also used for car paint and motion picture film

1952: The first video recorder was demonstrated in the United States

1975: Angola became independent after 500 years under Portuguese colonial rule
