November 13, 1930

▲ The Rotolactor, a rotating milking platform invented by Henry W. Jeffers that could milk 1,680 cows in seven hours, was installed at a dairy in New Jersey

1940: Walt Disney's *Fantasia*, featuring conductor Leopold Stokowski and Mickey Mouse, opened in New York

1980: The U.S. spacecraft *Voyager I* sent back the first close-up pictures of the planet Saturn

2015: Russia was suspended from all international athletics competition after allegations of "state-sponsored doping"

2015: Coordinated terrorist attacks targeting a concert hall, stadium and bars in Paris killed 130 people
