*November 16, 1855*

▲ Explorer David Livingstone discovered the Victoria Falls on Africa's Zambesi River. The indigenous name, Mosi-oa-Tunya, means "the smoke that thunders"

**1995:** Bosnian Serb leader Radovan Karadzic and his military commander Ratko Mladic were charged with genocide

**1995: Shimon Peres was confirmed as prime minster of Israel following the assassination of Yitzhak Rabin**

**2005:** China confirmed its first three human cases of bird flu following 11 outbreaks of the H5N1 strain in birds

**2010: The Beatles finally released their back catalogue on iTunes after years of legal wrangling over the Apple name**
