1905: Albert Einstein published a paper in the journal *Annalen der Physik* that led to the mass-energy formula $E = mc^2$

1985: Two French secret service agents were jailed for sinking the Greenpeace ship *Rainbow Warrior*

1995: In Dayton, Ohio, leaders of Serbia, Croatia and Bosnia agreed a deal to end the three-year Bosnian War

2017: Zimbabwe's President Robert Mugabe was ousted from power after 37 years of autocratic rule
