▲ **Turkey agreed to help stem the flow of migrants to Europe in return for cash and visas from the European Union, and renewal of talks on joining the EU**

1814: The Times of London became the first newspaper to be printed with steam power, rather than hand presses

1945: The newly elected **Constituent Assembly** in Yugoslavia proclaimed a federal republic

1990: The UN Security Council authorised “all necessary force” to ensure Iraq’s withdrawal from Kuwait

1995: The **CIA** reported that the Pentagon had used psychics for 20 years in intelligence gathering
