1915: The U.S. state of Georgia recognised the Ku Klux Klan, following its revival by white Protestant nativists

1965: NASA launched the Gemini 7 spacecraft to investigate the effects of space on the human body

1995: The first NATO troops landed in Sarajevo to enforce an accord ending four years of war in former Yugoslavia

2010: Spain's government imposed emergency measures unused since the end of military rule in 1975
