

# Boeing's 737 Max to fly again

Boeing's 737 Max has received U.S. regulatory approval to return to service following a nearly 20-month grounding after fatal crashes in Ethiopia and Indonesia killed 346 people

## AIRCRAFT DELIVERIES

**May 2017:** 737 Max enters service. First flight is made by **Malindo Air** – subsidiary of Indonesian carrier **Lion Air**

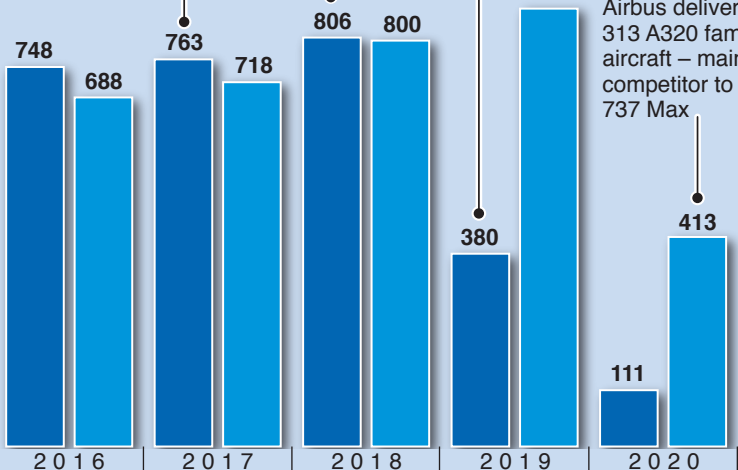
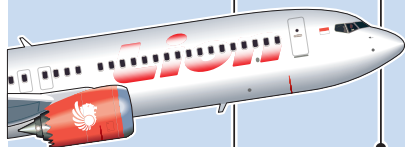

**Oct 29, 2018:** **Lion Air** 737 Max crashes killing all 189 people on board

**Mar 10, 2019:** **Ethiopian Airlines** 737 Max crashes killing all 157 passengers and crew

**Mar 13:** Global fleet of 386 737 Max jets grounded

**Jan-Oct 2020:** Airbus delivers 313 A320 family aircraft – main competitor to 737 Max
