

# Trump allies hoping for clemency

President Donald Trump has pardoned Michael Flynn, his first national security adviser, who pleaded guilty to lying to the FBI about his links to the Russian ambassador to Washington



## President Trump:

Has now granted 29 pardons, which wipe out convictions, and 16 commutations, which reduce prison sentences



## Michael Flynn:

Served as Trump's national security adviser for just 23 days in 2017  
**Nov 25, 2020:**  
**Pardoned**



## Conrad Black:

Biographer and friend of Trump. Convicted of fraud, obstruction of justice  
**May 15, 2019:**  
**Pardoned**



## Roger Stone:

Longtime friend and adviser convicted of lying under oath to Congress  
**Jul 10, 2020: Prison term commuted**



## Steve Bannon:

Former White House strategist faces criminal charges alleging he defrauded **"We Build The Wall"** donors



## Michael Cohen:

Pleaded guilty to crimes including payments of **"hush money"** to women who claimed they had sex with Trump



## Paul Manafort:

Former campaign chairman found guilty of tax and bank fraud. Sentenced to seven and a half years in prison



## George Nader:

Informal Trump adviser on foreign policy pleaded guilty to child sex charges. Sentenced to 10 years in prison



## Rick Gates:

Former deputy to Manafort, pleaded guilty to conspiracy charges in **Robert Mueller's** Russia-Trump campaign probe



## George Papadopoulos:

Trump aide served 14 days in prison for lying to FBI during Mueller's Russia inquiry
