December 29, 1940

▲ In World War II, German aircraft dropped thousands of incendiary bombs on London, causing the worst fire damage in the city since the Great Fire of 1666

1890: More than 200 Sioux Indians were massacred by U.S. troops at Wounded Knee, South Dakota

1952: The first transistor hearing aid was marketed in the United States. It weighed only 3.5oz

1965: North Vietnamese President Ho Chi Minh rejected unconditional peace talks offered by the United States

1995: A French cargo plane became the first aircraft in three years to land at the Bosnian city of Mostar
