▲ **North Korean and Chinese troops captured the South Korean capital Seoul. The city changed hands four times during the three-year Korean War**

1936: The first popular music chart based on record sales was published in U.S. Billboard magazine

1946: Riots broke out in the French cities of Paris and Rouen over bread shortages

2002: An internet survey found the number of websites fell by 182,000 in a month after the “dotcom” bubble burst

2016: Trading on China’s \$7.1 trillion Shanghai Composite index was suspended after it fell by 7%
