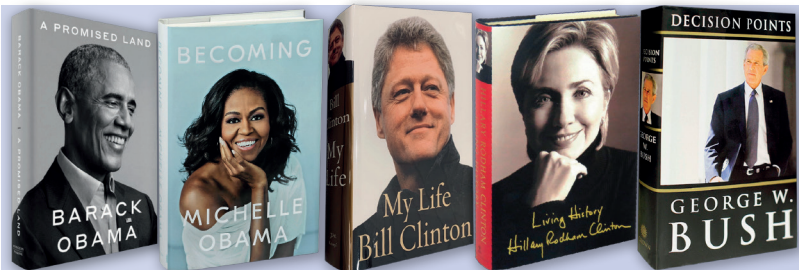


Best-selling political memoirs
