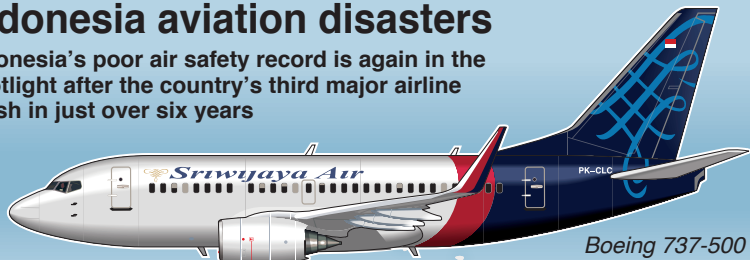


# Indonesia aviation disasters

Indonesia's poor air safety record is again in the spotlight after the country's third major airline crash in just over six years
