

# 737 Max to resume flights in Europe

The Boeing 737 Max will make a return to European skies following approval by the EU's air safety regulator for the once-grounded plane to fly again



**Mar 2019:** 737 Max grounded worldwide after crashes in Ethiopia and Indonesia kill 346 people

**Nov 2020:** EASA\* says jet is safe to fly after design changes and can return to service in Jan 2021

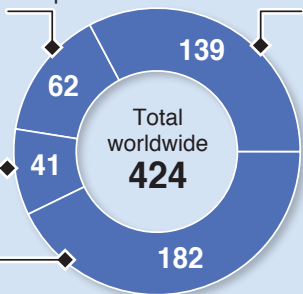
