2001: The EU and Norway imposed a 10-week ban on cod fishing in the North Sea to save dwindling stocks

2016: The UN reported that a record 3,545 civilians were killed in Afghanistan during 2015

2018: A shooting at a Florida high school killed 17 people and injured at least 14 others

2018: Cyril Ramaphosa became president of South Africa after Jacob Zuma resigned amid corruption claims
