

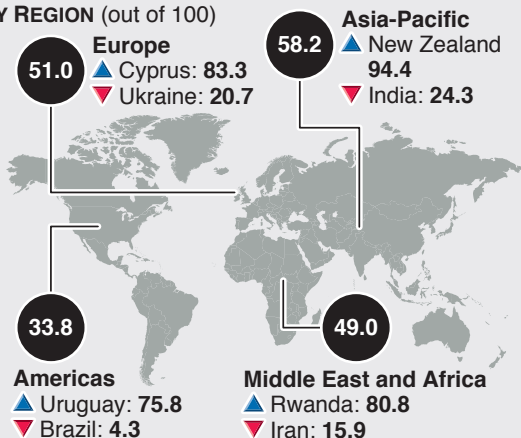
Pandemic best and worst performers
