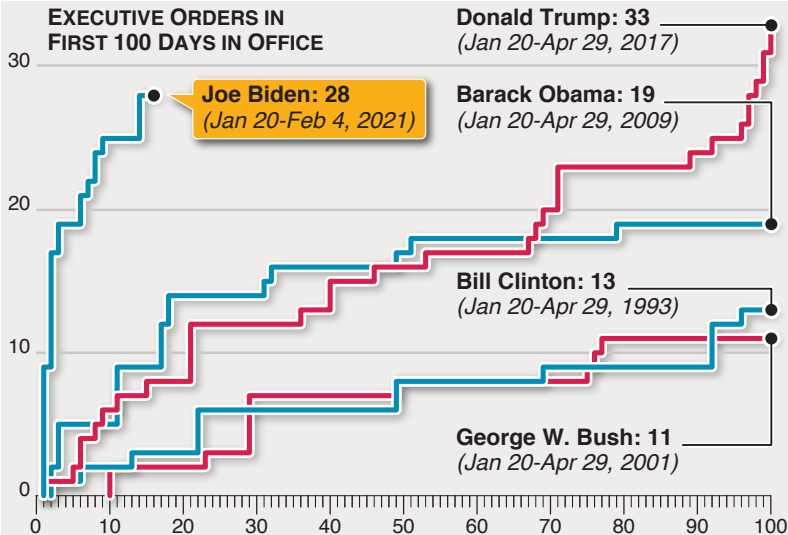


President Biden is off to record start
