▲ Britain's Prince Charles became engaged to Lady Diana Spencer. The marriage ended in divorce in 1996 and Princess Diana died in a car crash in Paris a year later

1938: The first nylon bristle toothbrush went on sale and rapidly replaced the traditional hogs hair

1946: Juan Peron was elected president of Argentina

1986: Ferdinand Marcos fled the Philippines after Corazon Aquino won the presidential election
