Sep 1947:
Born in Rome

1970: Degree in Economics, Sapienza University, Rome

1977: Doctorate in Economics at MIT, supervised by Nobel Prize winner **Franco Modigliani**



1975-81: Professor of Economics at universities of Trento, Padua and Venice

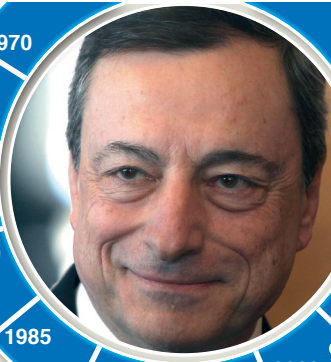
1984-90: Executive Director of World Bank

1981-91: Professor of Economics at University of Florence

1991-2001: Director General of Italian **Treasury**. Embarks on massive privatisation programme – from banks to utilities. **Condemned by critics as fire sale of Italy's crown jewels**
