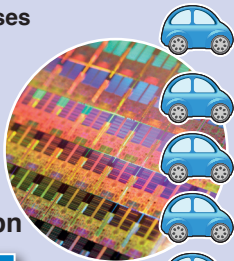
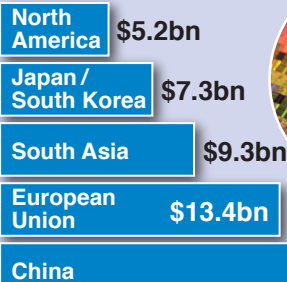


# Auto production lost to chip shortage

## European production losses (vehicles 2020, working days lost)

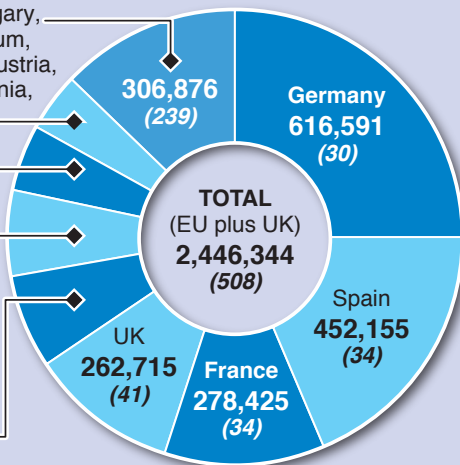
