▲ The Basque separatist group ETA declared an end to its 30-year armed campaign for independence from Spain, in which at least 800 people were killed

1857: The first department store elevator, invented by Elisha Graves Otis, was installed in New York City

1993: Intel shipped the first Pentium chips (80586), featuring a 60 MHz clock speed

2001: The first case of foot-and-mouth disease was confirmed in the Republic of Ireland
