▲ **Daimler's Mercedes 35 HP, regarded as the first modern automobile, made its debut. It was named after the daughter of the man who commissioned it**

**1891:** French post-impressionist painter Georges Seurat died at age 31

**2001:** A train-load of high level nuclear waste arrived at a storage facility in Germany, despite efforts by protesters to block the rail tracks

**2006:** Former Liberian president Charles Taylor was extradited to Sierra Leone to stand trial for war crimes

**2006:** The Beatles' Apple record label accused Apple Computer's iTunes Music Store of breaching their trademark
