▲ Iraqi-born British architect Zaha Hadid, whose dramatic designs include the Guangzhou Opera House (pictured above) in China, died aged 65

1861: The body of Napoleon Bonaparte was reinterred in Les Invalides in Paris 21 years after his death

1951: The first UNIVAC I computer, costing \$159,000 and weighing 16,686 pounds, was delivered for office use

1971: U.S. lieutenant William Calley was jailed for the killings of Vietnamese civilians at My Lai in March 1968

1994: Scientists reported the discovery in Ethiopia of an almost complete skull dating back over three million years
